

SRI PUTTRU MAHARISHI SOCIAL AND MEDICAL SERVICE CENTER

 Dr.K.P.Arjunan established this center in the year 1980 and continues as its Founder-President.

 Till February 2015, a total of 3883 Free Siddha Medical Camps were conducted.

In these camps, a total of 5,60,322 persons were diagnosed and treated with free Siddha medicines.
Till date 2688 Medicinal Plants Exhibitions were conducted.

Herbal Gardens were established in 565 homes.

1112 students underwent 4 years Gurukul System of Siddha Medicine Education. Traditional Siddha Medicine training were imparted to 46,200 persons.

SIDDHAR DAY FESTIVAL

Every year the first day of Chithirai month (usually 14th of every April) is being celebrated as World Siddhar Day. In commemoration with this day, ten days festival is being observed in this center. In the Siddhar Day, the idols of 18 Siddhars and Sri Puttru Maharsihi, idols of Deities are taken in a procession with folk dance across the streets of Sathuvachari. In these ten days, daily Music performance, Meetings, Seminars and Cultural programmes are held. In this festival, every year 3240 persons are allowed to perform Yagna on their own. In the 10 days Siddhar Festival held in the year 2013, free food were provided to 43,574 persons.

TAMILNADU PARAMBARIYA SIDDHA VAIDHYA MAHA SANGAM

✤ Dr.K.P.Arjunan established this Sangam in the year 2006 to bring all the traditional healers in the state under one umbrella. Foundation for Revitalisation of Local Health Traditions (FRLHT), Bangaluru has coordinated with Dr.Arjunan for the establishment of this Sangam. Till date 165 Taluk Associations were registered with 3,600 traditional healers as members.

Dr.K.P.Arjunan had served as State Secretary since inception to 2010 and later he was elected as State President and continues in the capacity till date.

In coordination with Forest Department of Govt. of Tamilnadu, Free Siddha Medical Camps were conducted in 1000 forest villages. By these camps a total of 42,086 persons were treated with free siddha medicines.

In close coordination with Field Publicity Offices, Vellore and Puducherry, Govt. of India several awareness programmes/workshop/seminars were conducted to popularize Medicinal Plants and Siddha System of Medicine among College & School Students and Women Self Help Group Members. Five Days Free Workshop for College Girl Students is a landmark among these publicity efforts.

In coordination with Govt. Museum, Vellore several awareness programmes were conducted for all walk of life.

In Javvadu Hills, a pilot project in control and treatment of anemia was implemented.

For traditional healers, periodically workshops were conducted in Medicine Making and to add efficacy and life to the Siddha Medicines.

In response to Adi Dravidar Welfare Department, the inmates of 37 student hostels were treated permanently for louse and dandruff.

From 2012 onwards, in coordinating with Sacred Heart College, Thiruppathur regular training programmes are being conducted every Wednesday. The course spreads for four weeks and the participants after attending the four classes are awarded with certificate.

TRADITIONAL HEALTH KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE PROGRAMME

FRLHT is implementing TRADITIONAL HEALTH KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE PROGRAMME among world countries. As a part of this exchange programme, Traditional Healers, Formal Doctors, Researchers in the field of Medicines from various countries and from various states of India had visited Shri Puttru Maharishi Social and Medical Service Center, Vellore.

Traditional Healers from Manipur, Jammu & Kashmir, Megalaya, Hariyana, Assam, Arunachalpradesh, Tiripura, Sikkim, Mizoram, Andhra, Karnataka, Kerala, Puducherry and Andaman were visited this center.

Traditional Healers from London, Bolivia, SriLanka, America, Uganda, Tanzania, South Africa, Peru, Netherlands, France, Thailand, Canada and Malaysia were visited this center.

During their visit to this center, they were exposed to the various aspects of Siddha System of Medicine and had a chance to interact Traditional Healers of Tamilnadu.

FRLHT convened during November 2011, an International Conference for Traditional Healers at Bangaluru. Dr.K.P.Arjunan has served as a member in the Coordination Committee of the Conference. In this conference Dr.Arjunan has been elected as National committee Secretary of Folk Healers Association India.
